

Gurjar Scholarship and Merit Awards

It is with great pleasure that Gurjar announces yet another year for its scholarship reward program. Gurjar scholarship fund is set-up with contributions from Gurjar members and well-wishers. Gurjar very much relies and appreciates the support of the community for this program. If you wish, feel free to send your contribution checks to Gurjar president or any committee member.

Gurjar will award 3 Merit awards to students who have received Top SAT scores. The amounts are \$100, \$75 and \$50 respectively. Additionally, Gurjar will also award several Scholarships in the sum of \$5000 in total.

The students will be ranked based on the following criteria and scholarship will be awarded based on an aggregated score. You can opt not to submit a given document for one or more of the criteria, but in that case, you will be awarded a "0" (zero) score for that criteria. Gurjar will maintain absolute confidentiality of the information that is submitted and will render an un-biased decision. In past, Gurjar has awarded the scholarship to all the applicants.

- 1. SAT Score (40% weight)
- 2. GPA (25% weight)
- 3. Commitment and participation for Gurjar activities (15% weight)
- 4. Extra-curricular activity (10% weight)
- 5. Community service and participation (10% weight)

All graduating high school seniors of Gurjar Life members are eligible to apply. If you are not a Gurjar life member, you can become one by February 28, 2007, and become eligible, provided that you have been a paid regular member for at least 3 of the last 4 years.

Students must submit an essay (300 words or less, type-written on $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper) with completely filled application. The topic of the essay is "My contribution to the Indian Community to preserve Indian culture". The essay is not part of a competition, just part of the application process. Some of the essays will be published in Gurjar newsletters and/or Gurjar web site. The essays will become the property of Gurjar. Awards will be announced/presented at the Gurjar Youth Program.
