
Gurjar Mission

Gurjar Governance Model


Role of Board of Trustees



- Selected for a 3-Year term, 6-Year Limit
- Monitor
 - Via Published financial results
 - Via Published Minutes of Meetings
- Financial Overseer
 - Monitor Budget Adherence
 - Approves fund-raisers
- Arbitration & Ethics
 - EC Member Termination
 - Candidate Nomination Rejection
 - Member Issues
 - Conflict Resolution
- Guidance & Counselling
 - During Transition
 - During candidate search
- Governance
 - Approves changes to Financial Framework
 - EC+BOT together approve Annual Budget
 - Votes along with EC to meet Quorum

INITIAL One-Time
Trustee Selection
3 Trustees with 2-Yr, 3-Yr
and 4-Yr Terms

- Constitution Committee nominates 5 people for the position of initial set of Trustees.
- This list along with credentials of each is presented to the EC
- Executive Committee appoints 3 of them to be the Trustees and assigns a term of 2 years, 3 years and 4 years.



New Quorum Requirements

- A quorum for a meeting of the members shall consist of at least twenty percent (20%) of the total voting members (including Absentee Voters) of the Association.

or

- At least 5% of the total membership (including Absentee Voters) not including the EC and the BOT members; and at least 75% of the EC committee members and at least two out of three Trustees.
