Happy New Year!

What a tremendous start to GURJAR's 2021-2022 year!

This Newsletter affords the Executive Committee and I an opportunity to retrace the successful events, lessons learned and our plans going forward.

We started the year with three major objectives:

- Restart Gurjar activities which were impacted by the Pandemic.
- Adopt new Gurjar Constitution and tune our approach to be compliant.
- Attract youth and offer activities that increase member participation.

Based on our past 6-months track record, I am very pleased to inform you that we have made significant progress in all three areas. Without very enthusiastic support from our membership none of this would have been possible.

Staying fully compliant with Commonwealth of Massachusetts's Department of Health guidelines, we began our activities with Heritage Fest, an outdoor event which brings together food vendors, merchandise seller and performers. Planning the event was not difficult but signing up food vendors who were facing severe labor shortage and merchandise vendors whose shipments from India were delayed was extremely difficult. On the costs side, we were asked to hire and deploy additional resources by the State. The pressure was ON but the Executive Committee was bold enough to press on and the results were astounding. Although we had about 10 less vendor tents and just two major food vendors, the turnout was more than expected. Event was applauded by Members, Performers and Vendors – and yes it was profitable! *Gujjubhai never loses sight of greenbacks*!

This success with Heritage got us all primed for the next event – Navratri! For the first time ever in Gurjar (and possibly ever in Massachusetts) we organized our Raas/Garba at an outdoor Football field. To get a venue for a late-night event and that too during high-school football season was difficult (to say the least) but to dance indoors with masks on was unacceptable and was deemed not enforceable. That brought us to one of what is now termed as a "Signature Event" of Dandiya under the Stars. The results and the environment were something which had to be experienced. We received feedback from many and most of them wanted to make an outdoor Navratri event an annual thing on our schedule. The number of attendees was staggering but we had space to accommodate them all. Yes – we will bring outdoor Navratri to our community every year, that's the plan. We may have to shift the date to coincide with a long weekend at schools, and possibly have it in October, but we will strive to make this an annual event.

An additional benefit of this successful event was getting the youth out at our event. The dressed-up youth showed up eager to dance the night away and more than anything else our signature outdoor Navratri event resulted in an exponential growth in our Facebook following and new memberships, mostly fueled by youth.

As shared at Diwali Event, Gurjar page following on Facebook went from few hundreds to over 3500 and our Life membership increased by 20 new families, which is 4/5 times the norm.

The feedback about the long-drawn-out check-in for the Navratri event and lack of multiple Food providers was noted and committee will act on it to make future Navratri experience a better one.

Our next monumental success came at our Diwali Event. We ventured into unchartered territory of COVID testing and figuratively stating can say that we slayed the beast. For any indoor event, the Committee was unanimous in looking out for their membership and wanted to provide a safe environment where folks can meet, greet, drink and dance together without having to worry about Social Distancing and Masking. Diwali Event was our first foray into onsite Rapid-Testing. The enthusiastic response and cordial follow through with prescribed process demonstrated by our members was phenomenal. As a result of announced strict checking, at least two families showing symptoms stayed away from the event. GURJAR refunded their costs without any questions. We were pleased to see Members being socially responsible and making GURJAR event safe for other attendees.

Executive Committee will be the sole arbitrator and decision maker for GURJAR awards, and their decision will be conveyed to the recipients a week prior to AGM.

Awards will be given during AGM and recipients are required to attend to accept their awards via the virtual session.
